Up to September 1 another Fellow from the sponsoring employer may apply or the funds retained for the following year. Fellows utilizing an approved payment plan who are unable to join the class are to fulfill their tuition in total; they may also recommend a substitute or defer participation. Any exceptions require board approval.
