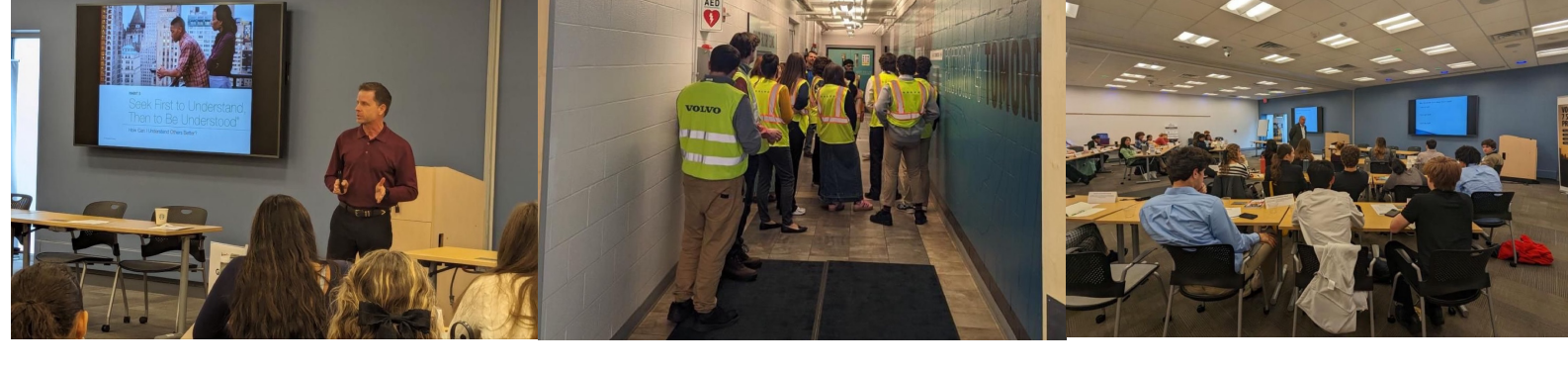


UNDERSTAND THEN BE UNDERSTOOD AT VOLVO CE

FELLOWS LEARN COMMUNITY BUILDING AND HOST FIRST EVER NONPROFIT VOLUNTEER FAIR!



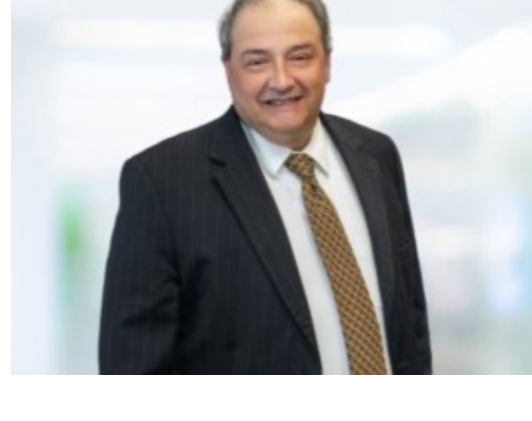
