After a welcome from Andy Williford at Volvo and lunch the class heard from Jennifer Wintermyer, Executive Director of Tri County Community Action with a Poverty Simulation and Discussion. To finish out the day Cate Mellen with Carlisle Family YMCA on Nonprofit Fundraising.

The Fellows also gave back to the community this month as part of the Advocacy portion of the Positive Leadership Curriculum they learn throughout the year. To effect change, leaders must make their case for a cause in a way that engages others in order to bring about needed results.

In these ways they donated snacks to Hope Station for their students in the After the Bell Club. After the Bell is a safe, inclusive space for youth living at Grandview Court and around Hope Station to come together for digital literacy, mentorship, continuing educational opportunities, life skills training, workforce development training and community. They also donated \$300 to two programs that are a part of the fellows class this year as well, Summer Program For Youth, helps children in the Carlisle Area School District grow academically, socially and emotionally over the summer, and Someone To Tell It To, an organization that cultivates meaningful relationships through compassionate listening, training, and educating others to do the same.

Enrollment is now open for our Fellows Class of 2024! The Leadership Cumberland Fellows Program serves the county by developing individuals, of all ages and professions, to become effective leaders in the workplace and community. Our program uses a Positive Leadership curriculum which is about harnessing the potential energy when people come together. It focuses on seven timeless capacities: Authenticity, Purpose, Advocacy, Resilience, Community-Building, Reason, and Gratitude.

Fellows participate in a ten-month program, from September through May, including a two-day retreat and day-long classes each month designed to address the identified outcomes above. Class sessions are held on the third Thursday of the month at various host locations around the County. Fellows also complete a board internship, serving as non-voting board members for a nonprofit of their choice. These experiences are then integrated into the class discussions.
